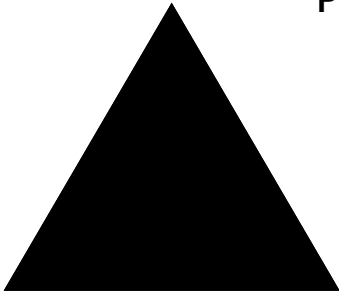

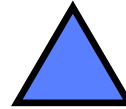

ARTICLE

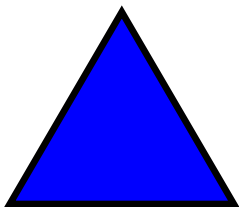
An **ARTICLE** is any of the following three words used to signal the presences of a noun.

ADJECTIVE

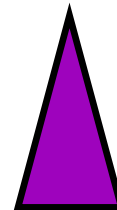
An **ADJECTIVE** is a word that modifies (describes) a noun or a pronoun.

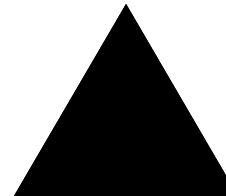

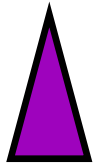
